STUDY QUESTIONS

TWO of these questions (or questions from the Midterm Study Guide) will appear on the exam. You will be asked to choose **ONE** of them and write an impressive essay. Essays should be two to three pages in length.

The remainder of the questions along with the reading assignments and lecture notes will be used to write short definition questions.

The test will consist of 5 short answer questions (1-2 sentences in length), completing the “Three Expressions of Faith” Table, and 1 essay question (2-3 pages in length).

1. Discuss the spiritual discipline of Confession as presented in *Celebration of Discipline*.
2. Discuss the spiritual disciplines of Submission and Service as presented in *Celebration of Discipline*.
3. Discuss the spiritual discipline of Worship as presented in *Celebration of Discipline*.
4. Discuss the spiritual discipline of Celebration as presented in *Celebration of Discipline*.
5. How do you think that churches and Christian organizations might be able to overcome the fragmented faith that separates the head, heart, and hands?
6. Deuteronomy 6:1-9 has been a significant passage for making God’s law a natural part of life. In our time, how might we make our faith a part of everyday life? What are some contemporary forms of “binding them [commandments] as a sign on your hand . . . writing them on the doorpost of your house? (HHH 158).
